

Annex 2: Statistical data within the response to the questions of the Committee for the Prevention of Torture

Question 5: Please include statistical data, classified by age and ethnicity or nationality of the victims, on the number of lawsuits, investigations, prosecutions, convictions and sentences recorded in cases of gender-based violence that have occurred since the consideration of the previous periodic report of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Response:

Statistics 2014: According to data collected from prosecutor's offices, law enforcement services, centres for social work and non-governmental organizations, in the period January - December 2014, a total of 49 potential victims of human trafficking were identified in BiH, primarily exploited for work or induced into prostitution and/or sexual exploitation, but also exploited for the purpose of organized and forced begging, sold for the purpose of entering into arranged or forced marriages, and for the production, possession and display of child pornography. Of the total number of 49 victims of human trafficking in 2014: 12 were adults (11 women and 1 man), and 37 were minors (24 women and 13 men), 35 were female persons, and 14 were male persons. Of the 35 recorded victims of human trafficking - women, 11 are adults, namely: 4 sexually exploited, 3 exploited for combined forced labor and begging, 3 exploited solely for begging, 1 exploited for the production, possession and display of child pornography. 24 are minors, namely: 6 sexually exploited, 14 exploited for begging, 4 sold for forced marriage and subsequent begging. Of the 14 recorded victims of human trafficking - men, 1 is an adult victim of begging, and 13 are minor victims of begging. Out of a total of 49 potential victims of human trafficking, 10 were sexually exploited, 3 were exploited for forced labor/labor exploitation, 31 for begging and 1 for the purpose of production, possession and display of child pornography and 4 for sale for the purpose of forced marriage/begging. Out of the 49 victims of human trafficking, 3 are female foreign nationals (Kosovo, Sri Lanka and Croatia), the remaining 46 victims of human trafficking are citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina. During the year, 14 potential victims of human trafficking were assisted in safe houses, 21 potential victims of human trafficking were assisted through the day centre/reception station, 1 in the Home for orphaned children in Bjelave Sarajevo, while 13 potential victims were not assisted because they refused. Additionally, in May 2014, the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina confirmed the indictment for the criminal act of organized crime from Article 250, paragraph 3, in connection with the criminal act of human trafficking from Article 186, paragraph 1 of the Criminal Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina. In this case, 672 victims of human trafficking were identified, of which 652 were citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina and 20 were foreign citizens (4 from Macedonia and 16 from Serbia), who were exploited for labor in Azerbaijan in an earlier period of time.

Statistics 2015: According to the data collected by prosecutors' offices, law enforcement services, centres for social work and non-governmental organizations, which are required for the preparation of the annual report on the state of human trafficking in Bosnia and Herzegovina, it was established that in the period January - December 2015, identified/assisted were a total of 35 potential victims of human trafficking/inducing prostitution and/or sexual exploitation/human trafficking for the purpose of begging/"sale, that is, for the purpose of marriage"/common law marriage with a minor. Out of the total number of potential/identified victims of human trafficking (35 VHT) in 2015: 18 adults and 17 minors. Of the 35 potential/identified victims of human trafficking, 27 are female persons (14 MINORS and 13 ADULTS) and 8 are male persons (3 MINORS and 5 ADULTS). Of the 27 potential/identified victims of human trafficking - women, 13 are adults, namely 6 sexual exploitation, 6 begging, and 1 inducement to prostitution. 14 are minors namely, 10 of them

begging, 4 sale for the purpose of forced marriage/marital union with a minor. Of the 8 recorded potential/identified victims of human trafficking - men, 5 ADULT victims of human trafficking of begging and 3 MINOR victims of human trafficking of begging. Out of a total of 35 potential/identified victims of human trafficking, 6 were sexually exploited, 1 was induced into prostitution, 24 were begging and 4 were sold for the purpose of forced marriage/marital union with a minor. During the collection of data by the competent institutions for 2015, we were informed that there were no foreign citizens who were victims of human trafficking. All collected and analyzed data refer to citizens of BiH. During the mentioned period, 14 potential victims of human trafficking were assisted in safe houses/shelters, while 21 potential victims were not assisted in shelters.

Statistics 2016: According to the data collected by prosecutors' offices, law enforcement services, centres for social work and non-governmental organizations, which are required for the preparation of the annual report on the state of human trafficking in Bosnia and Herzegovina, it was determined that in the period January-December 2016, identified/ assisted were a total of 47 potential victims of human trafficking/labor exploitation/induced prostitution and/or sexual exploitation/human trafficking for the purpose of begging/"sale, i.e. for the purpose of marriage"/production. Of the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (47 VHT) in 2016, 37 were adults and 10 were minors. Out of the 47 potential victims of human trafficking, 29 are female persons and 18 are male persons. Of the recorded 47 victims of human trafficking, 7 were sexually exploited, 12 labor exploitation, 21 begging, 1 sale for forced marriage, 1 labor exploitation/sexual, 5 begging/sexual. Out of the 47 victims of human trafficking, 5 are foreign citizens (3 are female persons - 2 are male persons), the remaining 42 victims of human trafficking are citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina. During the mentioned period, 14 potential victims of human trafficking were assisted in safe houses/shelters, while 33 potential victims were not assisted in shelters. In the activities that are realized by the organizations and associations that administer, i.e. provide day centre services, 28 (MINOR) potential victims of human trafficking were recorded.

Statistics 2017: According to available data collected from prosecutor's offices, law enforcement services, centres for social work and non-governmental organizations in Bosnia and Herzegovina, during 2017, 83 potential victims of human trafficking were identified who were trafficked for the purposes of labor exploitation, inducement to prostitution or other forms of sexual exploitation (10 victims), labor exploitation (7 victims), human trafficking for the purpose of begging (52 victims), and conclusion of forced or arranged marriages (5 victims) and other forms of exploitation of victims (4 acts of indecency, 1 sexual relation with a child, 2 common law marriage with a minor child, 1 minor caught at the border without documents and for 1 adult person the type of exploitation was not specified). Of the total number of victims of human trafficking, 36 victims are adults and 47 are minors, 58 victims are female and 25 are male, 2 victims are foreign citizens (1 adult - Dutch citizen, 1 minor - citizen of Libya), while the remaining 81 victims of human trafficking are citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina. 26 victims of human trafficking were assisted in safe houses, while 57 victims were provided with protection and assistance outside of safe houses. There were three voluntary returns (adults) from Slovenia and Croatia (labor exploitation), and 1 acceptance of a potential victim of human trafficking from Hungary (a minor).

Statistics 2018: The Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Department for the Fight Against Human Trafficking has, on the occasion of collecting and recording data in the reporting period from prosecutors' offices, law enforcement agencies, centres for social work and non-governmental organizations, which are necessary for compiling information on the state of human trafficking in Bosnia and Herzegovina for 2018, determined that a total of 36 potential victims of human trafficking/labor exploitation/induction into prostitution and/or

sexual exploitation/human trafficking for the purpose of begging/"selling, i.e. for the purpose of marriage"/ acts of indecency and others were identified/assisted in the said year.

Out of the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (36) in the period January - December 2018, 21 victims are female, and 15 victims are male. From the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (36) in the period January - December 2018, 12 victims are adults (9 are female and 3 are male), and 24 victims are minors (12 are female and 12 are male). From the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (36) in the period January - December 2018, the following forms of exploitation were recorded: 12 begging, 9 sexually exploited, 6 sales for forced marriage (combined with sexual exploitation or begging), 1 labor exploitation, 1 sexual relation with a child, 1 acts of indecency, 6 others. From the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (36) in the period January - December 2018, 8 victims are foreign citizens, and 28 victims are citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina. When it comes to foreign citizens, of a total of 8 victims: 3 victims are citizens of Montenegro (2 minors/male, 1 minor/female), 2 victims are citizens of Afghanistan (2 minors/male), 2 victims are citizens Sri Lanka (1 adult/ female, 1 minor/ male) and 1 victim is a citizen of Macedonia (adult/ male). During the mentioned time period, 10 potential victims of human trafficking were assisted in safe houses/shelters, while 26 potential victims of human trafficking were not assisted in safe houses/shelters.

Statistics 2019: The Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Department for the Fight Against Human Trafficking has on the occasion of collecting and recording data in the reporting period from prosecutors' offices, law enforcement agencies, centres for social work and non-governmental organizations, which are necessary for compiling information on the state of human trafficking in Bosnia and Herzegovina for 2019, determined that a total of 61 potential victims of human trafficking/labor exploitation/ induction to prostitution and/or sexual exploitation/ human trafficking for the purpose of begging/"selling i.e. for the purpose of marriage"/ acts of indecency/exploitation of a child or minor for pornography and others were identified/assisted in that year. Out of the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (61) in the period January - December 2019, 49 victims are female and 12 victims are male. From the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (61) in the period January - December 2019, 25 victims are adults (21 are female and 4 are male), and 36 victims are minors (28 are female and 8 are male). From the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (61) in the period January - December 2019, the following forms of exploitation were recorded: 36 begging, 15 sexually exploited, 3 sale for forced marriage (combined with sexual exploitation or begging), 4 child exploitation or minors for pornography and 3 others. Out of the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (61) in the period January - December 2019, 6 victims are foreign citizens, and 55 victims are citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina. When it comes to foreign nationals, from a total of 6 victims: 2 victims are Sri Lankan citizens (1 minor/male, 1 adult/female), 2 victims are citizens Afghanistan (2 minors/male) and 2 victims are citizens of the Republic of Serbia (1 adult/female and 1 minor/female). During the mentioned time period, 42 potential victims of human trafficking were assisted in safe houses/shelters, while 19 potential victims of human trafficking were not assisted in safe houses/shelters.

Statistics 2020: Based on the data collected by the newly formed coordination teams for the fight against human trafficking, a total of 70 potential victims of human trafficking were identified/assisted in 2020 in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Out of the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (70) in 2020, 51 victims are female, 14 victims are male, and 5 victims are of unknown sex. Out of the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (70) in 2020, 35 victims are adults (27 are female and 7 are male), and 35 victims are minors (24 are female and 7 are male). Of the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (70) in 2020, the following forms of exploitation were recorded: 38 begging, 17 sexually

exploited and 15 other forms of exploitation. Out of the total number of potential victims of human trafficking (70) in 2020, 7 victims are foreign citizens, and 63 victims are citizens of BiH. When it comes to foreign citizens, from a total of 7 victims: 2 victims are citizens of Syria (2 adults/female and male), 1 victim is from Afghanistan (minor/male), 2 victims are citizens of Iran (1 adult/ female and 1 minor/female) and 2 victims are from Serbia (2/female minors). During the mentioned time period, 41 potential victims of human trafficking were assisted in safe houses/shelters, and 29 potential victims of human trafficking were not assisted in safe houses/shelters. Number of investigations of cases of human trafficking: in 2015, the Prosecutors' Offices ordered 20 investigations against 30 people; In 2016 - 7 investigations against 33 people; In 2017 - 27 investigations against 38 people; In 2018 - 41 orders to conduct investigations against 79 people and in 2019 - 37 orders to conduct investigations against 48 people. Number of prosecuted cases of human trafficking: in 2015 Prosecutor's offices filed 9 indictments against 15 people; In 2016 - 5 indictments against 25 people; In 2017 - 9 indictments against 15 people; In 2018 - 26 indictments against 37 people and in 2019 - 20 indictments against 31 people.

Number of convicted perpetrators of human trafficking: in 2015, the courts in 2015 pronounced 10 convictions against 14 people, of which 7 were prison sentences against 9 people and 3 suspended sentences against 4 people. There was one acquittal against 2 people; In 2016 - 4 convictions against 10 people, of which 4 are prison sentences against 7 people and 1 suspended sentence against 3 people. Also, there was one acquittal against 1 person; In 2017 - 17 convictions against 17 people, of which 14 prison sentences against 14 people and 1 suspended sentence against 1 person, and 2 fines against 2 people. In the reporting period, there were also 3 acquittals against 3 people; In 2018 - 48 convictions against 48 people. When it comes to the type of sentences pronounced by the courts, the following were pronounced: 24 prison sentences against 24 people and 1 suspended sentence against 1 person and 2 fines against 2 people. In the reporting period, 2 acquittals were pronounced against 2 people; In 2019 - 34 convictions against 34 people. The courts made 4 decisions against 4 people, rejecting the appeal as unfounded and confirming the first-instance verdict. In the reporting period, 7 decisions were made on imposing corrective measures against 7 minors. When it comes to the type of sentences pronounced by the courts, the following were pronounced: 24 prison sentences against 24 people and 1 suspended sentence against 1 person, and 2 fines against 2 people. 1 measure of mandatory psychiatric treatment and custody in a health institution was also adopted. Also, in the reporting period, 4 acquittals were pronounced against 4 people.

Question 8: Please provide data on the number of asylum applications received during the considered period, the number of successful applications and the number of asylum seekers whose applications were accepted because they were tortured or might be tortured if returned to their country of origin. Please provide detailed information on the type of appeal mechanisms that may exist, any appeals made and the outcome of those appeals. Please provide details of the reasons for return, including a list of countries to which individuals have been returned.

Response:

Statistical data from the field of asylum for the reference period 2017 to November 23, 2021, are as follows: In 2017 382 people applied for asylum in Bosnia and Herzegovina, of which 335 were men and 47 were women. Countries of origin (top 10) are: Algeria 77 people, Pakistan 65 people, Syria 47, Afghanistan 41 people, Turkey 29 people, Morocco 26 people, Libya 22 people, Russia 15 people, Iran 10 people, Iraq 10 people. In the same year, 15 lawsuits were filed to the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina, against the decisions of the Sector for Asylum of Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina. All 15 lawsuits were

resolved. In 2017, the Sector for Asylum of the Ministry of Security of BiH granted 8 subsidiary protections, of which 6 subsidiary protections were granted due to the risk that foreigners will face inhumane, degrading treatment or punishment upon returning to their country of origin.

In 2018 1,572 people applied for asylum in BiH, of which 1,143 were men and 428 were women. Countries of origin (top 10) are: Iran 366 people, Pakistan 350 people, Afghanistan 334 people, Syria 189 people, Iraq 117 people, Libya 35 people, Morocco and Turkey 22 people each, Algeria and Yemen 18 people each and India 16 people. In the same year, 29 lawsuits were filed to the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina, against the decisions of the Sector for Asylum of the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina. All 29 lawsuits were resolved. In 2018, the Sector for Asylum of the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina granted 9 subsidiary protections, of which 4 subsidiary protections were granted due to the risk that foreigners will face inhumane, degrading treatment or punishment upon returning to their country of origin.

In 2019 785 people applied for asylum in Bosnia and Herzegovina, of which 466 were men and 318 were women. Countries of origin (top 10) are: Iraq 328 people, Iran 121 people, Afghanistan 79 people, Turkey 74 people, Pakistan 68 people, Syria 58 people, India and Palestine 9 people each, Algeria, Azerbaijan and Morocco 5 people each. In the same year, 15 lawsuits were filed to the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina, against the decisions of the Sector for Asylum of the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina. All 15 lawsuits were resolved. In 2019, the Sector for Asylum of the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina granted 19 subsidiary protections, of which 13 subsidiary protections were granted due to the risk that foreigners will face inhumane, degrading treatment or punishment upon returning to their country of origin.

In 2020 245 people applied for asylum in Bosnia and Herzegovina, of which 168 were men and 77 were women. Countries of origin (top 10) are: Iraq 72 people, Turkey 39 people, Afghanistan 31 people, Pakistan 18 people, Morocco 17 people, Iran 13 people, Syria 10 people, Cameroon 8 people, Algeria 6 people and Russia 5 people. In the same year, 22 lawsuits were filed to the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina, against the decisions of the Sector for Asylum of the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina. All 22 lawsuits were resolved. In 2020, the Sector for Asylum of the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina granted 13 subsidiary protections, of which 9 subsidiary protections were granted due to the risk that foreigners will face inhumane, degrading treatment or punishment upon returning to their country of origin.

In 2021 until the moment of writing the response (November 23, 2021), 144 people have applied for asylum in BiH, of which 105 were men and 39 were women. Countries of origin (top 10) are: Afghanistan 29 people, Turkey 28 people, Pakistan 27 people, Iran 21 people, Morocco 10 people, Iraq 9 people, Syria, Serbia, Western Sahara and Tunisia 3 people each; In the same year, 29 lawsuits were filed to the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina against the decisions of the Sector for Asylum of the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina, 15 of which were resolved. In 2021, the Sector for Asylum of the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina granted 10 subsidiary protections, of which 8 subsidiary protections were granted due to the risk that foreigners will face inhumane, degrading treatment or punishment upon returning to their country of origin.

Question 14: In light of the Committee's previous concluding observations (items 24-25), please inform the Committee of the measures taken to address the problems related to the special prison regime of enhanced surveillance in the Republic of Srpska. Please indicate whether the signatory state has taken measures to harmonize its legislation and practice in relation to closing a person into a cell for solitary confinement with international standards. This should include data on the use of a cell for solitary confinement during the observed period and an indication of its duration.

Response (RS):

In the corrective institutions in the Republic of Srpska during the observed period, a total of 423 disciplinary proceedings were conducted against prisoners who committed disciplinary violations. An overview of the number of conducted disciplinary proceedings and imposed disciplinary punishments of solitary confinement, by year, is shown in the table:
