



PORODICA MLAKIĆ



Milenko Mlakić, korisnik Državnog projekta stambenog zbrinjavanja u sklopu Regionalnog stambenog programa, ima četvero djece, a trenutno živi sa suprugom i dva sina u potpuno neuslovnom pomoćnom objektu na imanju svoje supruge. Porodica Mlakić željno iščekuje useljenje u novu obnovljenu kuću. Tokom ratnih dešavanja, Milenkova porodica je bila raseljena na području Općine Vitez. Kuća u kojoj su živjeli tokom rata je bila na prvoj borbenoj liniji, te je porodica Mlakić nekoliko puta mijenjala lokaciju prebivališta u drugim naseljima na području Viteza. Niti jedan član ove porodice nije stalno zaposlen, a jedino Milenko ostvaruje skromna primanja od biroa za zapošljavanje. Milenko je započeo gradnju nove kuće neposredno prije rata gdje je uspio kreditnim sredstvima izgraditi polovinu kuće. Sve što je izgrađeno potpuno je uništeno tokom rata. Uz pomoć donatora RSPa koji su osigurali sredstva, porodici Mlakić je potpuno obnovljena kuća, te je postavljen novi krov. Porodica Mlakić sada može početi s opremanjem novoizgrađenog objekta. Članovi ove porodice su, također, korisnici ekonomске pomoći koja je obezbjeđena od strane Catholic Relief Services. Dobili su plastenik površine 50 m², peć za zagrijavanje koja im služi za proizvodnju povrća tokom cijele godine i motokultivator. Tokom posjete predstavnika Evropske komisije i drugih učesnika RSPa u posjeti ovoj porodici Milenko i njegova supruga Marija su izrazili iskrenu zahvalnost donatorima RSPa koji su obezbjedili pomoć njihovoј porodici kako bi nakon više od 25 godina konačno imali osigurane stambene uslove za primjereni život.



MLAKIC'S FAMILY



Milenko Mlakic, the beneficiary of Country Housing Project, within a scope of Regional Housing Programme, has 4 children, and currently lives with his wife and two sons in completely inadequate auxiliary facility on the estate of his wife. Mlakic's family is eagerly awaiting to move in to a new, renovated house. During the war, this family was displaced in the area of Vitez Municipality. The house they lived in was on the first combat line during the war, so they were forced to changed their location several times in the Vitez area. No member of this family is permanently employed, only Milenko has a modest income from the employment bureau. Milenko started construction of his new home just before the war and he managed to build half of the house by loan fundings. Everything built was completely destroyed during the war. With the help of the donors of the RHP, who provided the funds, the house of the Mlakic's family was completely restored and the new roof was installed. The Mlakić family can now begin with furnishing the newly built facility. The members of this family are also beneficiaries of the economic assistance provided by the Catholic Relief Services. They have got a 50 m² greenhouse, a heating stove that serves them for the production of vegetables throughout the year and a motocultivator. During the visit of representatives of the European Commission and other RHP members to this family, Milenko and his wife Marija expressed their sincere gratitude to RHP donors who provided assistance to their families, so that after more than 25 years they would eventually have secured housing conditions for a decent life.
