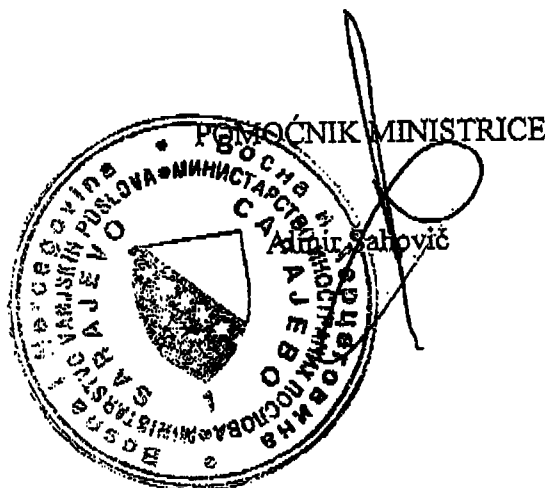
Tokom ovog sastanka planirano je da se održe izbori za pet članova Komiteta za prisilne nestanke.

**Subject: Elections of five members of the Committee on Enforced Disappearances during the sixth Meeting of States parties to the International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance**

The Secretary-General of the United Nations (Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights) presents his compliments to the Permanent Missions of States parties to the International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance and has the honour to refer to the forthcoming meeting of States parties to the Convention.

The sixth Meeting of States parties to the Convention will convene on 14 June 2021, at the United Nations Headquarters in New York. The prevailing circumstances linked to the pandemic do not allow to confirm yet whether in person meetings will be possible in June 2021. Therefore, the Committee will send further details about the modalities of the meeting (on-site or remotely) as soon as this information is available. ✓

This meeting will mainly focus on the election of five members of the Committee on Enforced Disappearances whose terms are due to expire on 30 June 2021. Pursuant to paragraph 7 of the General Assembly resolution 68/268 on the strengthening and enhancing the effective functioning of the treaty body system, the meeting may also comprise discussions on the implementation of the Convention. ✓

The Secretary-General, therefore, has the honour to invite all States parties to the Convention to submit nominations for membership to the Committee, in accordance with article 26, paragraph 3, of the Convention. Nominations and biographical data should be submitted using the attached Word format (Annex I), to the Secretary-General Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights at Geneva, Switzerland, by 1 March 2021 at the latest, at the following email address [ced@ohchr.org](mailto:ced@ohchr.org). ✓

In accordance with article 26 of the International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance, members of the Committee on Enforced Disappearances shall be elected by secret ballot from a list of persons nominated by States parties from among their nationals, at a meeting of States parties convened for this purpose. The Committee shall "consist of ten experts of high moral character and recognized competence in the field of human rights, who shall serve in their personal capacity and be independent and impartial. The members of the Committee shall be elected by States parties according to equitable geographical distribution. Due account shall be taken of the usefulness of the participation in the work of the Committee of persons having relevant legal experience and of balanced gender representation". According to paragraph 4 of article 26 of the Convention, the members of the Committee "shall be elected for a term of four years. They shall be eligible for re-election once".

The Secretary General would like to draw attention to General Assembly resolution 68/268, adopted on 9 April 2014 entitled "Strengthening and enhancing the effective functioning of the human rights treaty body system" and its paragraphs 10 and 13 on the nomination and election of treaty body experts:

"10. Encourages States parties to continue their efforts to nominate experts of high moral standing and recognized competence and experience in the field of human rights, in particular in

the field covered by the relevant treaty, and, as appropriate, to consider adopting national policies or processes with respect to the nomination of experts as candidates for human rights treaty bodies:"

"13. *Encourages* States parties, in the election of treaty body experts, to give due consideration, as stipulated in the relevant human rights instruments, to equitable geographical distribution, the representation of the different forms of civilization and the principal legal systems, balanced gender representation and the participation of experts with disabilities in the membership of the human rights treaty bodies."

The current gender and geographic composition of the membership of the Committee, as well as the list of the five members whose mandates will expire on 30 June 2021, are available in Annex II.

After the deadline for the submission of nominations and in accordance with article 26, paragraph 3, of the Convention, the Secretary-General shall prepare an alphabetical list of all nominated candidates, indicating the States parties which nominated them, and shall submit the list to all States parties, together with appropriate information concerning the sixth Meeting of the States parties.

**Predmet: Izbor pet članova Komiteta za prisilne nestanke na šestom sastanku Država potpisnica Međunarodne Konvencije za zaštitu osoba od prisilnog nestanka**

Generalni sekretar Ujedinjenih nacija upućuje pohvale Stalnim misijama Država potpisnica Međunarodne konvencije za zaštitu svih osoba od prisilnih nestanka i ima čast da se pozove na predstojeći sastanak Država potpisnica Konvencije.

Šesti sastanak Država potpisnica će se održati 14. juna 2021. godine u sjedištu Ujedinjenih nacija u Nju Jorku. Imajući u vidu trenutnu situaciju usljed pademije još uvijek nije sigurno da li će se u junu 2021.godine održati sastanak uz lično prisustvo. Stoga će se iz Komiteta poslati detalji o načinu održavanja sastanka čim takve informacije budu poznate.

Glavna tema sastanka jeste imenovanje pet članova Komiteta za prisilne nestanke obzirom da predhodnicima mandat ističe 30. juna 2021. godine. U skladu sa stavom 7. Rezolucije Generalne skupštine broj 68/268 o jačanju i unaprijeđenju operativnosti Sistema ugovornih tijela, tokom sastanka će se otvoriti diskusija vezana za implementaciju Konvencije.

S tim u vezi, Generalni sekretar ima čast da pozove sve Države potpisnice da nominuju člana Komiteta što je u skladu sa članom 26. stav 3. Konvencije. Nominacije i biografije trebaju biti poslate u Word formatu (Aneks I) do 1.marta 2021.godine na email adresu: [ced@ohchr.org](mailto:ced@ohchr.org)

U skladu sa članom 26. Međunarodne konvencije za zaštitu osoba od prisilnih nestanaka "Komitet za prisilne nestanke (dalje u tekstu "Komitet") se osniva kako bi vršio funkcije predviđene ovom Konvencijom. Komitet se sastoji od deset eksperata visokog moralnog karaktera i priznatih stručnosti u oblasti ljudskih prava, koji obavljaju funkciju u ličnom svojstvu i koji su nezavisni i nepristrasni. Članove Komiteta biraju Države članice u skladu s jednakom geografskom zastupljenošću. Uzeće se u obzir i korist učešća u radu Komiteta lica koja imaju odgovarajuće pravno iskustvo, kao i ravnomyerna zastupljenost polova. Prema paragrafu 4. člana 26. Konvencije, članovi Komiteta se biraju na mandat od četiri godine. Oni se mogu ponovo birati na još jedan mandat.

Generalni sekretar bi želio skrenuti pažnju na Rezoluciju Generalne skupštine 68/268, usvojenu 9. aprila 2014. pod nazivom "Jačanje i djelotvorno funkcionisanje sistema ugovornih tijela za ljudska prava" i paragrafe 10. i 13. vezane za nominaciju i izbor stručnjaka ugovornih tijela:

"10. Podstiče države članice da nastave s naporima i da nominuju stručnjake visokog moralnog karaktera i priznatih stručnosti u oblasti ljudskih prava, koji obavljaju funkciju u ličnom svojstvu i koji su nezavisni i nepristrasni i, prema potrebi, razmotre usvajanje nacionalnih politika ili postupaka u vezi s nominivanjem stručnjaka kao kandidata za ugovorna tijela za ljudska prava";

"13. Podstiče Države članice da, kako je predviđeno relevantnim instrumentima o ljudskim pravima prilikom izbora stručnjaka ugovornih tijela, dužnu pažnju obrate na ravnopravnu geografsku podjelu, zastupljenost različitih oblika civilizacije i pravnih sistema, ravnopravnost polova i učešće stručnjaka s invaliditetom u članstvu ugovornih tijela za ljudska prava. "

Trenutni rodni i geografski sastav članstva Komiteta, kao i spisak pet članova Komiteta čiji mandati ističu 30. juna 2021. godine, dostupan je u Aneksu II ovog dokumenta.

Nakon isteka roka za dostavu nominacija u skladu sa članom 26. Stav 3. Konvencije, Generalni sekretar će sastaviti listu kandidata po alfabetskom redu kao i listu Država koje su nominovale kandidate a koja će biti, zajedno sa agendom šestog sastanka biti dostavljena svim Državama članicama.
